Directions: *From North, South or West, by way of Route 287 to River Road exit in Piscataway.*

Follow River Road toward Highland Park. Drive two miles. Johnson Park runs parallel with River Road. Turn right onto Johnson Drive. Follow park road to Grove #1 near the petting zoo, and the playgrounds.

Directions: *From East, North and South by way of Route #1*

Exit Rte #1 at New Brunswick to travel north on Rte #18. Take exit to the right for Highland Park/Rte #27 (Raritan Ave.) Drive short distance over the bridge and turn left at traffic light onto River Road. Johnson Park begins on the left at 1st traffic light (Cedar Lane). Turn left at the light and follow park roadway to Grove #1 on the right, before the Duck Pond.
