- **2. Welcome** As we extend the heart and hand of fellowship to those who still suffer, let us be mindful of OA's Unity with Diversity Policy, which respects our differences, yet unites us in the solution to our common problem. Whatever problem you may have with food, you are welcome at this meeting.
 - -We strive for consensus, fairness, and an informed group conscience within the spirit of the Traditions and Concepts, loosely following Robert's Rules. Majority rule is not the same as group conscience.
 - -Please turn off all cell phones and texting devices at this time so that we can devote our full attention to working together for a positive and productive meeting.
 - -Please raise your hand to be recognized. No crosstalk.
- **3.** Tradition 12: "Anonymity is the spiritual foundation of all these traditions, reminding us to place principles before personalities."
 - We welcome all who wish to stop eating compulsively to our meetings no matter what we think of them. Even heathens who hang toilet paper under the roll rather than correctly (over).
 - If a Nobel Peace Prize winning astronaut movie star becomes a member of Overeaters Anonymous, when they enter our rooms they are a compulsive overeater. Just like everyone else, no greater and no less.
 - Treating particular members or speakers of OA like celebrities is misleading to the newcomer and unfair to the person being treated like a celebrity.
 - OA meetings are like Vegas: what happens here stays here, be it the nature of an individual's shares or whether an individual was even present.
 - Gossip goes against the spiritual principle of this tradition.
 - We can tell friends from outside of the program that we know someone who we met in the program but we don't tell them WHERE we know them from out of respect for the anonymity of another.
 - It is acceptable for an individual to disclose to a non fellow that they are a member of OA so long as they are not disclosing this on social media or other forms of broadcast communication (on the news, etc).
 - Point of confusion: It is NOT a violation of the 12th Tradition to tell someone in the fellowship your last name. (However, you are not required to do so either.) If a person uses their last name in a meeting we avoided having it recorded either on audio or in any transcribed notes that may be published.
