## Presentation to Residents on 9/2/2025

Our CJI Outreach committee made a 2 hour presentation to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year residents at RWJ Medical School.

At the end of the event we discussed the six handouts that was sent to them by email and gave out some pens "swag" with the OA contact on them and the pamphlet "When should I refer someone to Overeaters Anonymous".

The Residents were very impressed with the program as was exhibited by the questions and comments they shared. The Director of the program also made a point to make sure that we are able to make a similar presentation next year about the same time.
